Record Setting 9th Annual Black Ties Blue Jackets Gala

The 9th Annual Black Ties Blue Jackets Gala was held at the Enrichment Center on Saturday, February 18, 2023. It was wonderful to see the building flooded with the biggest supporters of Agriculture Education once again. With more than 120 silent and live auction items and 402 attendees, we were able to raise a record amount of \$138,561!

Throughout the night, individuals and corporate partners continuously bid on auction items, bought chances for games and raffle items and made monetary donations. The silent auction saw 992 bids from 413 different bidders before the silent auction closed and netted \$12,991. The live auction, cried by past lowa FFA State President, CD Brinegar, raised \$14,410.

lowa FFA President, Sam Martin and lowa PAS President, Kirsten Schaefer took the group through an evening with comments from Secretary of Agriculture Mike Naig and Iowa FFA Foundation Board President, Jason Berkland. Josh Remington spoke about the goal of implementing agriculture education in every school in Iowa and announced bill HF389 which addresses the issue of summer contract days for agriculture educators. To celebrate the start of National FFA Week, the FFA Creed was presented by the 2022 Iowa FFA Creed Speaking Champion, Emma Lihs from the Bondurant-Farrar FFA Chapter and it rang true in the hearts of every attendee.

Staying on the night's trend of supporting education and FFA members, the entertainment was presented by a central lowa native who grew up on a farm and a former FFA Member, Ted Gaunt.

The support at Gala this year was wonderfully overwhelming. It is so exciting to be reminded just how strong the support of agriculture education is in the state of Iowa. Mark your calendars for the 10th Annual Black Ties Blue Jackets Gala on February 17, 2023. We will see you next year!
