

As we start each year, many of us do just that, we set goals and resolutions. While it is standard for many to search for new ways to improve their health, it is also a newer trend to

Because of you, in 2022 we awarded 24 new agricultural educators \$1,000 each. Then, this fall, we awarded six student teachers \$500 each. To compound this, we just approved five more new educators for a \$1,000 award and 21 more student teachers their \$500 award! This \$42,500 investment marks one unique way we are stating the Iowa FFA Foundation – and you as our donors and supporters are truly ALL IN for Ag. Education! I hope you feel proud of this great investment and the impact it will have for many years to come!

As we start this New Year, I am optimistic of the goals we have set and know together we can make 2023 the best year ever for agricultural education in Iowa!
