

# Heartland Co-op Scholarship Program

## Heartland Co-op

Heartland Co-op is one of the largest grain and farm supply companies in Iowa. Heartland Co-op serves over 5,500 members from 51 communities in Iowa. Heartland Co-op is the largest employer in most of these communities with over 385 full-time employees.

## Objectives

The primary goal of the program is to encourage area youth to prepare for a career in agriculture. This scholarship program is designed to provide college financial assistance to dependents of Heartland Co-op members.

## Scholarship Amount

Heartland Co-op will offer ten \$1,000 scholarships to full-time agriculture students through the Iowa FFA Foundation. The first payment of \$500 will be made the beginning of the first semester. The second semester check for \$500 will be presented to the scholarship winner at the annual meeting of Heartland Co-op held the first part of September. The Heartland Co-op board of directors has designated the Iowa FFA Foundation to appoint a selection committee to review the applications and rank the scholarship recipients.

Continuation of the scholarship program shall be reviewed annually.

## \$1,000 Scholarship Eligibility

1. Applicant shall be a Heartland Co-op member or a dependent of a Heartland Co-op member at the time of application.
2. Applicant shall be a full-time student that has been accepted into a college program that offers an agricultural degree, or a 2-year transferable ag program to go on and major in an agricultural curriculum. *Applicant shall enroll in one or more agriculture classes each semester of his/her scholarship year.*
3. The college's agriculture program *must be in Iowa.*
4. Directors and officers of Heartland Co-op, their spouses and/or dependent children, shall be prohibited from receiving a Heartland Co-op scholarship.
5. Scholarship recipient can receive a Heartland Co-op scholarship one time.
6. These scholarships are available to applicants who are undergraduate students in two or four year programs. High school seniors, as well as college freshmen, sophomores and juniors are eligible to apply; Heartland Co-op scholarships can be awarded to college freshmen through seniors.



# HEARTLAND CO-OP SCHOLARSHIP

## AGRICULTURE 2011-2012 Academic Year

Heartland Co-op will offer ten (10) scholarships of \$1,000 each through the Iowa FFA Foundation. These will be awarded to undergraduate students in two or four year college programs. Recipients will be selected according to the following criteria: 1) outstanding leadership potential, 2) good scholarship, and 3) financial need. Applicant must be a full-time student that has been accepted into an Iowa college program that offers an agricultural degree, or a two-year transferable ag program to go on and major in an agricultural curriculum. *One or more agriculture classes shall be taken each semester of the scholarship year.* **The postmark deadline for applications is March 12, 2011.**
