

DLL Financial Solutions Scholarship

Objectives

The primary goal of this scholarship program is to encourage FFA members throughout Iowa to prepare for their chosen career field. This scholarship program is designed to provide a college scholarship to students needing financial assistance.

Scholarship Amount

The DLL Financial Solutions Scholarship Fund will offer **one** scholarship each to **two** full-time students. Each scholarship awarded in 2019 will be \$2,350 - half of this scholarship will be paid directly to the scholarship recipient's college in August. After successfully completing the first semester of eligible enrollment with a minimum semester GPA of 3.0 the second payment will be made.

Scholarship Eligibility

1. Applicant must be an Iowa resident.
2. Applicant shall be an FFA member with current, active membership that has been accepted into a college program or a 2-year transferable program. Applicant must attend an Iowa college or university.
3. Applicant must have a high school Grade Point Average of 3.0 in a 4.0 scale and maintain this 3.0 GPA while in college.
4. This scholarship is available to high school seniors.

2019-2020 Academic Year

The Iowa FFA Foundation will administer one scholarship to two FFA members who will be an undergraduate student in a two or four year college program for the 2019-2020 academic year. **For 2019-2020, each scholarship will be \$2,350.** Applicant must be a full-time student that has been accepted into an Iowa college program or a two-year transferable program. The postmark deadline for applications is March 1, 2019.
