You can make an important difference in the future of Iowa agricultural leadership through a planned gift. By informing the Iowa FFA Foundation that you have provided for it in your estate plans, you will be honored and recognized in your lifetime.

Your age, estate size and income level must be carefully considered in determining the type of gift that best fits your needs.

Here are a few planned gift options that may fit your situation. This information is not intended as legal advice and we recommend you consult your legal or tax advisor to find a plan that best benefits you.

### Bequest in a Will

If you wish to make a gift through your will to the Iowa FFA Foundation, you can provide for the gift in your will by using language like the following:

*I give, devise and bequeath [ \_\_\_\_\_ ]  
Percent ( \_\_\_% ) of my estate] or  
[ \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars ( \$ \_\_\_\_\_ ) to  
the Iowa FFA Foundation, Ankeny, Iowa.*

### Beneficiary Designated Accounts

Accounts such as IRAs, 401(k)s and life insurance policies will pass at your death to the persons and organizations that you designate as beneficiaries. It is easy to change beneficiaries by contacting the service provider administering the account. You can make modest or larger gifts, since the shares designated to family members and the Iowa FFA Foundation can be allocated fractionally.

### Life Insurance Policy

You can make a significant gift with a modest investment by naming the Iowa FFA Foundation as the beneficiary of a life insurance policy at your death. If the Iowa FFA Foundation owns the insurance policy, you may receive an income tax deduction for the premium payments you gift to the foundation.

### Revocable Living Trust

A revocable living trust is an alternative to a will and may allow you to avoid the probate of your estate if you title all of your assets in the name of the revocable trust. At your death, the trust assets can be maintained in the trust or distributed to designated beneficiaries such as the Iowa FFA Foundation.

### Charitable Lead Trust

With a charitable lead trust, you transfer assets to a trustee who distributes either a fixed amount or a percentage of the trust to the Iowa FFA Foundation every year. At the end of the trust term, the remainder of the trust property is distributed to you or the people you specify, such as your family.

### Life Income Gifts

A life income gift of cash, securities or real estate allows you to retain a stream of income while receiving current tax benefits.

- **Charitable Gift Annuity**  
You will receive a guaranteed income for life in exchange for a charitable gift.
- **Charitable Remainder Unitrust**  
You transfer assets to a trust and instruct the trustee of the trust to pay a fixed percentage of the trust property every year for a certain term or for your life. At the end of the term of the trust, the remaining property passes to the Iowa FFA Foundation.
- **Charitable Remainder Annuity Trust**  
You transfer assets to a trust and instruct the trustee of the trust to pay a fixed dollar amount from the trust property every year for a certain term or for your life giving you a fixed and predictable payment. As with a charitable remainder trust, at the end of the trust term, the remaining property passes to the Iowa FFA Foundation.
